

SUMMARY OF ITEM FOR ACTION, INFORMATION OR DISCUSSION

TOPIC: University System of Maryland: Self-Support Charges and Fees for FY 2011

COMMITTEE: Committee of the Whole

DATE OF COMMITTEE MEETING: April 16, 2010

SUMMARY: The procedure for approving student-related tuition, fees, and charges is a two part process. This item involves the approval of the non-mandatory auxiliary enterprise charges.

Proposed increases in the typical annual dormitory charge are listed below:

\$1,002 to \$1,052	5.0%	University of Maryland, Baltimore (Monthly Rate)
\$5,549 to \$5,714	3.0%	University of Maryland, College Park
\$3,929 to \$4,126	5.0%	Bowie State University
\$5,256 to \$5,520	5.0%	Towson University
\$3,930 to \$4,008	2.0%	University of Maryland Eastern Shore
\$3,474 to \$3,510	1.0%	Frostburg State University
\$4,686 to \$4,920	5.0%	Coppin State College
\$4,150 to \$4,350	4.8%	Salisbury University
\$5,670 to \$5,860	3.4%	University of Maryland, Baltimore County

The percent increases for board range from 1.0% at Frostburg State University to a high of 6.0% at Bowie State University.

<u>ALTERNATIVE(S)</u>: The expenditures planned for each self-supported activity are based on the revenue produced from the schedule of charges. A decrease in the charge structure would require a corresponding decrease in planned expenditures

FISCAL IMPACT: The proposed charges and fees are determined to be the amount required to produce the revenue for the individual activities to operate on a viable fiscal basis without accumulating a deficit or postponing required expenditures to a future year.

<u>CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the Board of Regents approve the proposed self-support charges and fees for FY 2011 as set forth in the attachment.
