TOPIC: Opening Fall 2010 Enrollment and FY 2011 Estimated FTE Report

SUMMARY: This report provides an overview of preliminary fall 2010 undergraduate, graduate and first professional enrollment – overall enrollment growth, full-time and part-time enrollment patterns and decreasing numbers of first-time full-time freshmen. USM enrollment reached other record high — 152,497 students. Enrollment is up 2.6 percent (+3,821 students) from last fall. Estimated FY 2010 FTE are also included in this report.

The Committee on Education Policy discussed this report at its November 11, 2010 meeting.

Fall 2010 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment

Enrollment Background:

The Maryland Higher Education Commission requires each public and private institution to submit preliminary fall enrollment figures as part of its annual data collection. Such data are important for fiscal, as well as enrollment, management. Enrollment totals, broken down by gender and enrollment status (e.g., full time or part time status), are collected for undergraduate, graduate and first professional students. Undergraduate first-time student totals, broken down by gender and full-time/part-time status, are also collected. For further information, please contact Chad Muntz, cmuntz@usmd.edu (301-445-2737).

Enrollment Highlights:

- Fall 2010 headcount enrollment at the University System of Maryland (USM) campuses reached 152,497 students. That was up 2.6 percent (3,821 students) from fall 2009. While total enrollment increased for the USM, the rate at which that growth occurred actually slowed between fall 09 and fall 10. (See Table 5)
- Most USM institutions had little growth with three (Coppin; Bowie; and University of Maryland, Baltimore) decreasing in headcount enrollment in Fall 2010. More than half of the total enrollment growth (56%) was accounted for by a single USM institution: University of Maryland University College (UMUC). (See Table 1).
- For the second year total enrollment at the USM's historically Black institutions (HBIs) remained almost flat, increasing just 67 students (or +0.5%) to 13,918 in fall 2010. This reflected moderate growth at University of Maryland Eastern Shore (+107) being slightly offset by a decline at Bowie (-39) and stability at Coppin (-1). (See Tables 1 and 4)
- In terms of student attendance status, the USM experienced overall growth in fall 2010 in both full-time and part-time enrollments, at both the undergraduate and graduate/first-professional level. Full-time undergraduate enrollments were up 2.0% and graduate/first professional were up 2.1%, while part-time undergraduate enrollments were up 4.9% and part-time graduate/first-professional were up 2.3%. (See Tables 2 and 5)
- At the same time, the number of USM students attending as first-time, full-time undergraduates decreased by 368 students (headcount). For the second year in a row, first-time, full-time undergraduate enrollment fell, going from a high of 13,213 in fall 2008 to 12,894 in fall 2009 to 12,547 in fall 2010. This rapid decline means the USM first-time, full-time enrollment is now below fall 2006, the first year of the Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI). (See Table 3)
- Ten-year trend data for each institution as well as the percentage of each institution's enrollment to the USM total are shown in Table 5.

Fall 2010 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment

FY 2011 Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTE) Estimate:

Fiscal year 2011 is the second year without support from the Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI). That initiative, designed to address the state's demand for higher education access, dedicated state dollars specifically for expanded enrollment at USM institutions. The enrollment measure used for funding was full time equivalent students or FTES. During the three years of EFI, USM grew by approximately 11,500 FTE students (or 15,000 headcount students). In effect, the USM grew enrollment in an amount equal to the population at UMBC. Over the past two years, however, during which there has been no EFI funding though the retention rate of those admitted during the EFI years has remained high, USM has grown an additional 5,500 FTE or a number slightly larger than the student population at Bowie.

The chart below provides an estimated FY 2011 FTE for each USM institution. USM prepared the annualized FTE estimate using a conservative methodology that calculated the proportion of spring to fall credit hours by level for each institution for each of the past five fiscal years. An average spring to fall proportion over the past five fiscal years was then calculated. This proportion was applied to fall 2010 credit hours to estimate 2011 spring credit hours. The USM estimate was then compared with individual institutional budget projections and an estimate was formulated as highlighted below.

FY 2011 FTE Estimate Highlights:

- USM state-funded FTEs were budgeted for little growth from FY 2010 to FY 2011.
- Most USM institutions are estimated to exceed their FY 11 Budget Projections and FY 2010 Actual FTE. (See Table below)


