Meeting Notes

- 1. Update on coalition case. The presidents were briefed on the status of the coalition case by Mr. Killefer and Ms. Skulnick of the Office of the Attorney General.
- 2. 403(b) Plan Amendments. Ms. Langrill of the Office of the Attorney General briefed the presidents on changes to the 403(b) plan.
- 3. FY 2012 Compensation Issues. Chancellor Kirwan and Mr. Vivona briefed the presidents on a number of issues regarding faculty and staff compensation for FY 2012. The topics included the USM salary guidelines, \$750 bonus, faculty and staff retention issues, and collective bargaining.
- 4. Capital Budget Workshop Follow-up. The presidents were provided with information as follow up to the BOR capital budget workshop regarding strategies and priorities for USM capital development.
- 5. Discussion of UMCP/UMB Merger Study. Chancellor Kirwan reviewed a draft proposal for the JCR requiring a study of a potential merger of UMCP and UMB.
- 6. Parental Leave General Discussion. The presidents and Chancellor Kirwan reviewed and discussed a proposal for a parental leave/primary care giver policy for faculty.
- 7. BOR Policy Institutional Advisory Boards. Ms. Ryan, Senior Advisor to the Chancellor and staff to the BOR Organization and Compensation Committee, briefed the presidents on a proposed change to the BOR policy on institutional advisory boards that will be taken to the June 17 meeting of the BOR.
- 8. Discussion on Intercollegiate Athletics. Chancellor Kirwan and Dr. Goldstein briefed the presidents on recent issues/concerns of the BOR regarding intercollegiate athletics, gender equity, and highly compensated employees.
