Update on STEM Workforce Production

Context

- USM conducted Studies in 2007-2008 on STEM Workforce Production and Demand in Maryland
- Formed the basis for the "Caret Report" findings
 - Demand present for increased STEM production
 - Demand present for increased STEM Teacher production
 - Demand was not uniform and certain critical disciplines had much higher demand
- Informed State STEM report



Update

- STEM Enrollment has risen sharply (up 4,500 in two years)
 - Upper division enrollment has risen by 1,000 per year since 2007
- STEM Degree Production is rising (up more than 450 since 2009)
 - STEM Degrees at highest level ever in USM
- STEM Teacher production largely flat (stable around 100-125 per year)
- Mixed results in specific Critical STEM areas
