Notes from Executive Session

March 29, 2012 Towson University

Regent Attman called the meeting of the Finance Committee of the University System of Maryland Board of Regents to order in public session at 10:02 a.m. Regent Attman moved and Regent Gossett seconded to convene in closed session. At 10:02 a.m., the Committee voted unanimously to go into closed session under State Government Article Section 10-508(a).
