

SUMMARY OF ITEM FOR ACTION, INFORMATION OR DISCUSSION

TOPIC: University System of Maryland: Self-Support Charges and Fees for FY 2013

<u>COMMITTEE</u>: Finance Committee

DATE OF COMMITTEE MEETING: March 29, 2012

<u>SUMMARY</u>: The procedure for approving student-related tuition, fees, and charges is a two part process. This item involves the approval of the non-mandatory auxiliary enterprise charges.

Proposed increases in the typical annual dormitory charge are listed below:

To accommodate the variation in the beginning dates of their academic programs, University of Maryland, Baltimore charges a daily rate. The proposed daily rate for FY 2013 for a one bedroom apartment is \$36.69. The 8.2% increase in Salisbury's room rate represents the third and final year of a planned three-year phased-in set of increases for the purpose of renovating rooms as part of its Comprehensive Housing Renovation Program.

The percent increases for board range from 0.8% at Salisbury University to an increase of 7.1% at Bowie State University. Increases at BSU are related to the addition of flex dollars to the meal plans that will allow students to buy more retail food and convenience items on campus. In addition, to better meet the students' needs, the dining halls will have longer hours, additional late night offerings, a new franchised venue and more menu offerings.

<u>ALTERNATIVE(S)</u>: The expenditures planned for each self-supported activity are based on the revenue produced from the schedule of charges. A fee decrease would require a corresponding decrease in planned expenditures.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: The proposed charges and fees are determined to be the amount required to produce the revenue for the individual activities to operate on a viable fiscal basis without accumulating a deficit or postponing required expenditures to a future year.

<u>CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the Finance Committee recommend that the Board of Regents approve the proposed self-support charges and fees for FY 2013 as set forth in the attachment.
