



**TOPIC**: Opening Fall 2013 Enrollment and FY 2014 Estimated FTE Report

**COMMITTEE**: Education Policy and Student Life

**DATE OF COMMITTEE MEETING**: November 20, 2013

**SUMMARY**: This report provides an overview of preliminary fall 2013 undergraduate, graduate and first professional enrollment – overall enrollment growth, full-time and part-time enrollment patterns and decreasing numbers of first-time full-time freshmen.

USM headcount enrollment declined for the second year with 2,159 fewer students for a total of 153,444 students. The impact on the FY 2014 FTE is projected to slightly be lower (-518) than FY 2013 for a total FTE of 119,782.

#### Fall 2013 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment

#### **Enrollment Background:**

The purpose of this report is to provide the Board of Regents a fall enrollment and full-time equivalent (FTE) estimate for the current fiscal year. The Maryland Higher Education Commission requires each public and private institution to submit preliminary fall enrollment figures as part of its annual data collection. Such data are important for fiscal, as well as enrollment management. Enrollment totals, broken down by gender and enrollment status (e.g., full-time or part-time status), are collected for undergraduate, graduate and first- professional students. Undergraduate first-time student totals, broken down by gender and full-time/part-time status, are also collected. #### **Enrollment Highlights:**

- Fall 2013 headcount enrollment at the University System of Maryland (USM) campuses was 153,444 students. Enrollment fell 1.5 percent (-2,159 students) from fall 2012. (See Tables 1 & 5)
- Five of the 11 of the USM institutions (Bowie, Frostburg, Towson, UMBC, & UMCP) increased a combined 1,027 in headcount enrollment in fall 2013. However, the gains were mostly offset by the decreases at UMUC (-2,585), UMES (-239) and Coppin (-229). (See Table 1)
- Total enrollment at the USM's Historically Black Institutions (HBIs) decreased for the second year in a row. Total enrollment fell by 2.4 percent (-323 students) from fall 2012 to 13,164 in fall 2013. While the graduate enrollment was relatively stable, the undergraduate enrollment has decreased for the fourth straight year to a nine year low of 10,808 in fall 2013. (See Tables 1 & 4)
- In terms of attendance status by level, USM experienced decreases from fall 2012 to fall 2013 in full-time and part-time attendance status at both the undergraduate and graduate level. Full-time enrollments for undergraduate (-0.1%) decreased the least followed by decreases in graduate/first-professional (-1.2%) students. Part-time undergraduate student enrollments also decreased (-1.6%), while graduate/first-professional students experienced the largest drop (-5.3%) in enrollments for fall 2013. (See Tables 2 & 5)
- After four years of decreased enrollments, USM first-time, full-time students increased to 12,494 in fall 2013 (+364). First-time, full-time undergraduate enrollments are still below a high of 13,213 in fall 2008, the highest level before the Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI) ended. (See Table 3)

Ten-year trend data for each institution as well as the percentage of each institution's enrollment to the USM total are shown in Table 5.

#### Fall 2013 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment

#### FY 2014 Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTE) Estimate:

Fiscal year 2014 is the fifth year without support from the Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI). That initiative, designed to address the state's demand for higher education access, dedicated state dollars specifically for expanded enrollment at USM institutions. The enrollment measure used for funding was full-time equivalent students or FTES. During the three years of EFI, USM grew by approximately 12,000 FTE students (or 15,000 headcount students). In effect, the USM grew enrollment in an amount equal to the population at UMBC. Over the three immediate years following EFI funding, USM has grown an additional 10,000 FTE or a number similar to the combined population at Frostburg and Bowie. Five years after EFI, USM is projected to decrease FTE for the second year in FY 2014.

The chart below provides an estimated FY 2014 FTE for each USM institution. USM prepared the annualized FTE estimate using a conservative methodology that calculated the proportion of spring to fall credit hours by level for each institution for each of the past five fiscal years. An average spring to fall proportion over the past five fiscal years was then calculated. This proportion was applied to fall 2013 credit hours to estimate 2014 spring credit hours. The USM estimate was then compared with individual institutional budget projections and an estimate was formulated as highlighted below.

#### FY 2013 FTE Estimate Highlights:

- USM state-funded FTEs were budgeted for slight growth from FY 2013 to FY 2014.
- Based on fall 2013 enrollment, USM is estimated to be 2200 below Budgeted FTE. (See Table below)
