### Summary of New Companies Facilitated by USM Institutions by Tier

#### Tier 1: 5 total

UMCP – Total: 3 licensed university-owned IP
 UMB – Total: 1 licensed university-owned IP
 UMCES – Total: 1 licensed university-owned IP

• Total Women-Owned: 1

### Tier 2: 56 total

- UMBC Total 2: 1 company moved into UMBC's incubator and received mentoring and 1 company received significant mentoring
- UMCP Total 38: 31 companies received significant mentoring through the Fearless Founders Program at the Dingman Center; 1 company received significant mentoring through the Fearless Founders Program at the Dingman Center and is a Pitch Dingman Competition Grant winner; 6 received significant mentoring through the Regional I-Corps Program through MTech
- SU Total: 3 received significant mentoring in the Shore Hatchery
- SBDCs Total of 13 received significant mentoring (UMCP & UMB, Corridor Region -8; Salisbury – 2; FSU - 3)
- Total Women-Owned: 6

#### Tier 3: 31 total


- UMCP Total: 1 is a Pitch Dingman Competition Grant winner

- Total Women-Owned: 2




Note: The scale for the Y-axis is logarithmic.

### **Examples of New Companies:**

### Chemical

<u>GripBoost, LLC</u> – Licensed a quick-drying polymer-based gel technology that can extend the life and performance of football gloves.

### **Medical Device and Equipment**

<u>Breethe, Inc.</u> – Focused on the development of the "world's first wearable artificial lung" based off technology developed in UMB's Cardiovascular Surgery Department.

### Pharmaceuticals/HealthCare

<u>GlycoMantra, LLC</u> – Focused on the development of carbohydrate-based therapeutics of cancer and infectious disease.

### **Energy/Consumer Technology**

Manta Biofuel - Focused on renewable crude oil from algae that is grown in open waters

### IT/Technology

<u>Mookie</u> – Provides a mobile/desktop platform that facilitates new ways to help pay down a student's debt by utilizing their downtime by taking short surveys, watching commercials/trailers or trying mobile apps for market research.

### Retail

<u>BackPack'Em, LLC</u>- Focused on developing a centralized marketplace that allows students to buy/sell items within the campus network.
