



TOPIC: University System of Maryland: FY 2016 Operating Budget

**COMMITTEE**: Committee of the Whole

**DATE OF COMMITTEE MEETING**: May 6, 2015

**SUMMARY**: The FY 2016 operating budget reflects state-wide actions that significantly reduce the State's structural budget deficit. All state employees, including USM employees, will experience a reduction in pay given the reversion of the January 2015 2% Cost of Living Adjustment. The tuition increase included in the budget will help maintain quality and support services to the extent possible, and mitigate the negative impact on instruction and student services. The budget does not include funding for program enhancements or enrollment increases and will require base reduction actions to balance the budget.

The total USM budget includes revenue from state appropriations, tuition and fees, auxiliary services, federal and other contracts and grants, endowment income and other revenues for a total budget of \$5.1 billion.

The state supported portion of the budget totals \$2.9 billion. Included in the \$2.9 billion are state appropriations of \$1.2 billion (an increase of \$15.4 or 1.3%), tuition & fees of \$1.4 billion (an increase of \$53 million or 4%) and other revenues of \$251 million (a decrease of \$9.1 million or 3.5%).

The net increase of \$59 million in state supported funding will be used for:

Health insurance and other fringe benefit costs
 Facilities, debt service, utilities and financial aid
 \$25M

Reflected in the FY 2016 Appropriation are budget reduction actions to achieve the \$40 million structural decrease.

<u>ALTERNATIVE(S)</u>: The budget request could be adjusted to increase/decrease expenditures or to move expenditures from one area to another. <u>However, a balanced budget is required and revenue must be adjusted to match any increase in overall expenditures.</u>

**FISCAL IMPACT**: The USM budget totals \$5.1 billion.

**CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION**: That the Board of Regents approve the FY 2016 operating budget as submitted, with the Chancellor authorized to make appropriate changes consistent with existing board policies and guidelines. Any such changes will be reported back to the Board.
