**TOPIC**: Board of Regents' Staff Awards

**<u>SUMMARY</u>**: The Board of Regents' Staff Awards were established in 1999 to recognize outstanding performance on the part of staff members of the University System of Maryland community.

The award is comparable to the Board of Regents' Faculty Award. Only employees of the USM community may be nominated. All regular and Contingent II nonexempt and exempt staff who have been employed at least five consecutive academic years are eligible. The award consists of a \$1,000 stipend (\$500 from the Board of Regents and \$500 from the home institution), and a certificate recognizing the award.

A committee of the Council of University System Staff (CUSS) screened the nominees in four categories (service to the institution, service to students, public service and effectiveness and efficiency) and forwarded the names to the Regents for approval; **these were approved at the June 19, 2015 board meeting.** The awardees were honored at a special celebration breakfast prior to the board meeting today.
