## USM BOARD OF REGENTS University of Maryland Eastern Shore October 9, 2015

## **Minutes for Closed Session**

Call to Order. Chairman Shea called the meeting of the University System of Maryland Board of Regents to order in closed session at 10:05 a.m. on Friday, October 9, 2015 at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, Allen J. Singleton Multi-Purpose Room, Student Services Center. Those in attendance were: Chairman Shea; Regents Augustine, Brady, Comitz, Gooden, Gossett, Gourdine, Michaux Gonzales, Neall, Pevenstein, Rauch, and Slater; Chancellor Caret, Ms. Doyle, and AAG Bainbridge. President Bell, Interim President Bowling, President Dudley-Eshbach and Vice Chancellor Boughman participated in a portion of the meeting.

- 1. Meetings with Presidents. The regents met individually with Interim President Bowling and President Dudley-Eshbach to review the status of meeting their goals and objectives as part of their performance evaluation. (3-305(b)(1)(i)).
- 2. Committee of the Whole. Chancellor Caret briefed the regents on the items to be discussed in closed session at the Board retreat on October 23, 2015 (3-103(a)(1)(i)); Ms. Bainbridge gave the regents an update on the coalition case (3-305(b)(8)); and the regents met with a president to discuss a performance issue (3-305(b)(1)(i)).
- 3. Committee on Finance. The regents approved a University System of Maryland Master Contract for On-Site Renewable Energy (Moved by Regent Pevenstein, seconded by Regent Gossett, approved with Regent Gooden abstaining from the discussion and vote) ((3-305(b)(14)); and the regents were briefed on the performance of the USM Common Trust Fund Investment by the University System of Maryland Foundation (3-305(b)(5)).
- 4. Committee on Audit. The regents were briefed on legislative audit matters that are ongoing and, therefore, confidential (3-305(b)(13)) and investigative matters which may lead to criminal prosecution (3-305(b)(12)).
