SUMMARY: The University System institutions are permitted to undertake certain high impact entrepreneurial initiatives under Chapter 450 and a provision known as HIEDA—High Impact Economic Development Activities. This provision allows for the USM and its institutions to establish, manage and fund entities that contribute to the development and growth of the Maryland economy through education, job creation and technology transfer. A HIEDA policy is currently under development and will be submitted to the Board for its consideration in the fall.
