- 1. **Discussion about FOP negotiations**. Mr. Vivona briefed the regents on the status of FOP negotiations at several system institutions.

- 3. Coaches' contracts subject to review under BOR VII-10.0, Policy on board of Regents Review of Certain Contracts and Employment Agreements. The committee members were provided with information on the coaches' contracts for UMCP's football program.
- 4. **USMO compensation study**. Mr. Vivona briefed the regents on the reasoning behind doing a compensation study for USM presidents and the Chancellor. He outlined the options available after issuing the RFP.
