

USM BOARD OF REGENTS University of Maryland, College Park Minutes for Closed Session April 21, 2017

Call to Order. Chairman Brady called the meeting of the University System of Maryland Board of Regents to order in closed session at 11:21 a.m. on Friday April 21, 2017 at the University of Maryland, College Park, College Park, MD.
