

## USM Board of Regents Committee on Organization and Compensation Minutes from Public Session June 12, 2019 USG

## **Minutes of the Public Session**

Regent Gossett called the meeting of the Organization and Compensation Committee of the University System of Maryland Board of Regents to order in public session at 8:31 a.m. on Wednesday June 12, 2019 in the Multipurpose Room, Building II, Universities at Shady Grove, Shady Grove, MD.

- 1. Review of I-4:00: Policy on Institutional Advisory Boards. The Committee approved revisions to the policy and asked the OAG to draft a conflict of interest statement for members of Boards of Visitors to sign (Moved by Regent Gooden, seconded by Regent Neall; unanimously approved).
- 2. Review of I-3.00: Policy on University System Student Council. The Committee approved revisions to the policy that outline student participation in search committees (Moved by Regent Wood, seconded by Regent Gooden; unanimously approved).
- **3. BOR Policy Review Annual Report.** Ms. Wilkerson provided a report of the policies that each committee reviewed during 2018-2019.
- **4.** Chancellor Search Guidelines. The Committee reviewed Chancellor Search Guidelines in preparation for the upcoming Chancellor search.
- **5.** Reconvene to closed session. There was a motion to convene in closed session to discuss the topics set forth in the closing statement, matters exempted from the Open Meetings Act, under the General Provisions Article, §3-305(b) (1) (i): the appointment, employment, assignment, promotion, discipline, demotion, compensation, removal, resignation or performance evaluation of appointees, employees or officials over whom it has jurisdiction; (1) (ii) any other personnel matter that affects one or more specific individuals; and (9) to conduct collective bargaining negotiations or consider matters that relate to the negotiations (Moved by Regent Gossett, seconded by Regent Gooden; unanimously approved).
