## Fall 2007 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment and FY 2008 Estimated FTE Report

### Enrollment Background:

The Maryland Higher Education Commission requires each public and private institution to submit preliminary fall enrollment figures as part of its annual data collection. Breakdowns by gender and enrollment status are collected for undergraduate, graduate and first professional students. Undergraduate first-time totals by gender and enrollment status are also collected. Preliminary fall enrollment data are important for enrollment and fiscal management especially in light of the State's decision to dedicate resources specifically to enrollment growth. ### Enrollment Highlights:

- Fall 2007 headcount at the University System of Maryland (USM) reached a record high 137,412 students; up 1.5 percent from last fall's enrollments (+2,093 students). This total enrollment figure excludes UMUC's overseas students. (See Table 1)
- Bowie, Frostburg, Salisbury, Towson, UB, UMB, UMBC and UMCP experienced enrollment growth between 1.7 and 9.4 percent. Under Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI), the Regent's designated Salisbury, Towson and UMUC as the primary growth institutions for the System for fiscal 2008. Salisbury grew 2.7 percent and Towson grew 4.4 percent (+198 and +837 respectively). UMUC enrollment declined by 792 students (-2.4 percent) as did Coppin (-4.2 percent) and UMES (-1.1 percent). (See Tables 1 and 5)
- Full-time enrollment growth was healthy at both the undergraduate and graduate/first professional levels. Full-time enrollment grew 2.2 percent at the undergraduate level (+1,508) and 4.2 percent at the graduate/first professional level (+637). (See Table 2)
- Undergraduate part-time students decreased 486 students (-1.7 percent) due primarily to fewer enrollments at UMUC. Graduate/first-professional part-time enrollment grew 1.9 percent (+434). (See Table 2)
- First-time, full-time undergraduate enrollment at USM institutions reached another record high of 13,072 students in keeping with peaking high school graduation levels associated with the "Baby Boom Echo" population surge. The fall 2007 cohort includes the first freshmen class at the University of Baltimore (151). Between fall 2006 and 2007, first-time full-time undergraduate enrollment increased 387 students or 3.1 percent. Bowie, Frostburg and Salisbury had the largest freshmen classes enroll this fall at plus 820, 1,059 and 1,144 students respectfully. (See Table 3)
- The total enrollment dropped at the HBCU's (-0.8 percent) this fall due to enrollment declines at Coppin (-172 students) and UMES (-44 students). Bowie grew by 2 percent (+113) students. (See Tables 1 and 4)
- Ten-year trend data for each institution as well as the percentage of each institution's enrollment to USM total are shown in Table 5.

## Fall 2007 Preliminary Opening Fall Enrollment and FY 2008 Estimated FTE Report

### FY 2007 Full-time Equivalent Student (FTE) Estimate:

In fiscal year 2008, with the support of the Governor and the General Assembly, the USM continued its Enrollment Funding Initiative (EFI). The initiative, designed to address the state's demand for higher education access, dedicated state dollars specifically for expanded enrollment at USM institutions. Through EFI, the USM anticipated adding an additional 1,740 FTE students during FY 2008. Utilizing a relatively conservative estimation procedure, the 2007 USM enrollment target has been achieved. During the two years of the EFI, the USM will have added nearly 10,000 headcount and over 5,000 FTE students. The FTE measure is important because it represents the basis for State funding of the initiative.

The chart below provides an estimated FY 2008 FTE for each USM institution. USM prepared the annualized FTE estimate using a methodology that calculated the proportion of spring to fall credit hours by level for each institution for each of the past five fiscal years. An average spring to fall proportion over the past five fiscal years was calculated. This proportion was then applied to fall 2007 credit hours to estimate spring credit hours. The USM estimate was then compared with individual institutional projections and a consensus estimate was formulated as highlighted below. .

### FY 2008 FTE Estimate Highlights:

- USM state-funded FTEs are estimated to grow approximately 2,357 FTEs over the FY 2007 level.
- USM/Institution FY 2008 FTE projections show growth over the FY 2007 actual at each institution with the exception of Coppin and UMES. Both Coppin and UMES experienced enrollment declines in fall 2007 and this estimate fully recognizes these data. Designated growth institutions – Salisbury, Towson, UMB and UMCP anticipate meeting or exceeding the FY 2008 EFI target. UMUC anticipates exceeding its FY 2007 actual.

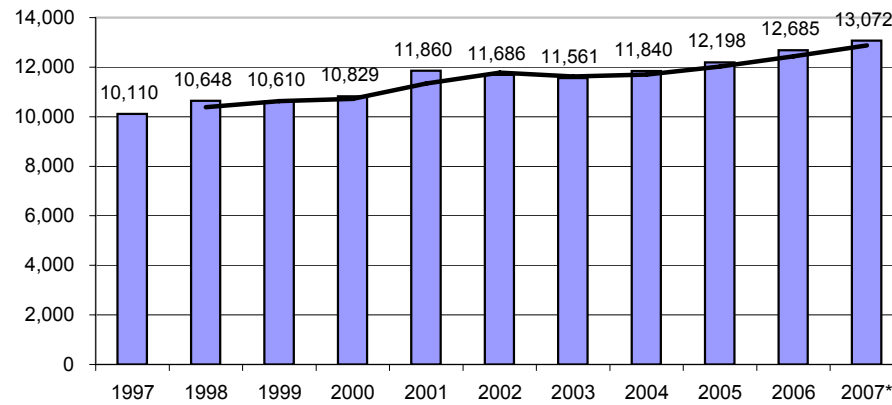
