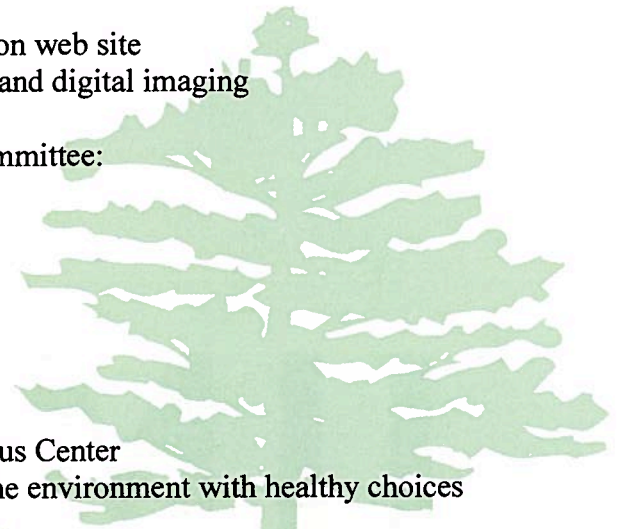

- ❖ Comprised of key leadership from the offices of Facilities Management, , Parking, Planning, Procurement, External Affairs; representatives from the schools, the Faculty Senate, the Staff Senate, and the UMMC are also part of this committee
- ❖ BTU/gsf went from 186000gsf to 178000gst in 2008
- ❖ Current initiatives for the Design/Construction Committee:
 - Incubator space for research labs
 - LED lighting
 - Solar photovoltaic installation at Hidden Waters
 - Solar thermal project at the Saratoga Building
- ❖ Current initiatives for the Operations Committee:
 - Recycling of electronics and batteries
 - Recycle rate of 34% for paper, plastic, and cans campus wide
 - Goodwill containers on campus
 - Goodwill shop located in the BioPark
 - Websites to auction used equipment
 - Turn In Your Trashcan program
