

COUNCIL OF UNIVERSITY SYSTEM PRESIDENTS November 7, 2016

Meeting Notes

The Council of University System Presidents met on November 7 with Chancellor Caret and USM senior staff.

Chancellor Caret provided information about online-hybrid courses across the USM. He noted that in the future, UMUC aims to provide a platform and expertise to universities worldwide to offer online courses. The Chancellor and Ms. Moultrie also provided an update about the status of the USM scorecard, which will provide an overview of the progress of strategic plan priorities.

Chancellor Caret and Ms. Doyle presented the goals from the CUSP Retreat and asked for any additional feedback from the presidents. President Perman read a letter from the CUSF chair inviting the presidents to the joint meeting between CUSF, CUSS, and the USMSC, as well as Annapolis Day, which is organized by the three councils. Ms. Moultrie discussed the Light City festival and asked for feedback about pooling dollars to support a joint sponsorship.

Dr. Boughman discussed Title IX complaint handling at USM institutions and the presidents had a conversation about this. Mr. Hogan, Mr. Vivona, and Mr. Sadowski briefed the presidents about a meeting they had with the Governor's new Chief of Staff concerning workforce and economic development. Mr. Vivona gave a brief update about the FY 18 budget and Chancellor Caret provided information about the latest Managing for Results (MFR) report.
