

Scaling OER in Human Growth and Development

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PROJECT BACKGROUND

- EDPS 208 (now 210) adopted OER in 2013
 - 2 Online sections
- Objectives of 2018 M.O.S.T grant included
 - Update existing OER for currency
 - Move all Online sections and one face to face section to OER
 - Complete Quality Matters Review on an OER course



- In 2017, FCC Formalized the OER Development Initiative
 - Develop 2 OER Degree Pathways
 - Increase high enrollment Gen Ed OER options
 - Continue professional development around teaching with digital resources
 - Identify no cost/low cost courses in the schedule

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY

"Objectives first" approach for the course design

Objectives and assessments were developed prior to resource selection

Team approach to resource selection and vetting

- 2 education faculty members
- 1 instructional designer
- 2 library staff
- 1 writing center staff member for editing

IMPACT

EDPS Project Impact

- Since 2013, 47 sections of EDPS 208 (now 210) have used OER
- 910 students impacted
- \$90,000+ saved

FCC OER Development Initiative Impact

- 40+ courses developed
- 106+ sections per semester run as no cost/low cost
- \$400,000+ savings

LESSONS LEARNED

- Online students preferred the digital resource
- Face to face student preferred a hard copy
- Do not recreate the wheel, instead build off of existing resources

FUTURE PLANS

- Create a sustainability plan
- Faculty professional develop for creating renewable assignments
