STATUTORY AUTHORITY TO CLOSE A SESSION

Md. Code, General Provisions Article §3-305(b):

(1)		To discuss:
	[X]	(i) The appointment, employment, assignment, promotion, discipline, demotion, compensation, removal, resignation, or performance evaluation of appointees, employees, or officials over whom it has jurisdiction; or
	[]	(ii) Any other personnel matter that affects one or more specific individuals.
(2)	[]	To protect the privacy or reputation of individuals with respect to a matter that is not related to public business.
(3)	[]	To consider the acquisition of real property for a public purpose and matters directly related thereto.
(4)	[]	To consider a preliminary matter that concerns the proposal for a business or industrial organization to locate, expand, or remain in the State.
(5)	[]	To consider the investment of public funds.
(6)	[]	To consider the marketing of public securities.
(7)	[]	To consult with counsel to obtain legal advice on a legal matter.
(8)	[]	To consult with staff, consultants, or other individuals about pending or potential litigation.
(9)	[]	To conduct collective bargaining negotiations or consider matters that relate to the negotiations.

To discuss public security, if the public body determines that public (10)[] discussions would constitute a risk to the public or public security. including: (i) the deployment of fire and police services and staff; and (ii) the development and implementation of emergency plans. (11)To prepare, administer or grade a scholastic, licensing, or qualifying [] examination. To conduct or discuss an investigative proceeding on actual or possible (12)[] criminal conduct. (13)To comply with a specific constitutional, statutory, or judicially imposed [] requirement that prevents public disclosures about a particular proceeding or matter. (14)[] Before a contract is awarded or bids are opened, to discuss a matter directly related to a negotiation strategy or the contents of a bid or proposal, if public discussion or disclosure would adversely impact the ability of the public body to participate in the competitive bidding or proposal process. (15)[] To discuss cybersecurity, if the public body determines that public discussion would constitute a risk to: security assessments or deployments relating to information (i) resources technology; network security information, including information that is: (ii) 1. related to passwords, personal identification numbers, access codes, encryption, or other components of the security system of a governmental entity; 2. collected, assembled, or maintained by or for a governmental entity to prevent, detect, or investigate criminal activity; or

3. related to an assessment, made by or for a governmental entity or maintained by a governmental entity, of the vulnerability of a
