



VII-11.0 POLICY ON STANDARDS, QUALIFICATIONS, AND PREREQUISITES FOR UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND POLICE OFFICERS

(Approved by the Board of Regents on April 16, 2010)

I. PURPOSE AND APPLICABILITY

This policy establishes the standards, qualifications, and prerequisites of character, training, education, human and public relations, and experience for University of Maryland police officers, including standards for the performance of their duties. For the purpose of this policy, “University of Maryland Police Officers” is defined as all police officers of the University System of Maryland.

II. UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND POLICE OFFICER STANDARDS

- A. University of Maryland police officers shall comply with:
 - 1. all standards established by the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commissions (MPCTC) under COMAR Title 12 Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, Subtitle 4 Police Training Commission, and in internal MPCTC guidelines; and
 - 2. other relevant standards established in COMAR or any Maryland statute that pertain to Maryland police officers.
