**Student Inclusion on Sexual Assault Adjudication Panels**

The student council passed Resolution #4 (attached) this week via e-ballot. The passage of this legislation represents the council's opinion that students should be trained and included in student conduct hearings at all institutions, proportionate to their resources, to ensure integrity, fairness, respect for all parties involved. The student council is taking this stand publicly in opposition to a recommendation from the Office for Civil Rights that states students not be involved in the adjudication process.

**Lobbying Efforts**

The council's efforts toward developing a successful lobby day in Annapolis have been continuing under the leadership of our Director of Government Affairs, Kennard Wallace (UB). The council has been discussing the issues and we are actively revising our agenda for our state lobby day. The student lobby day will be hosted on February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
