This month, the USMSC Executive team and I had an opportunity to meet with the new Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Student Success, Dr. Alison Wrynn. We had a great time getting to know her and discussing with her about the projects and initiatives the USMSC are working on this year.

Advocacy Day was this past Wednesday, and I want to take this opportunity to thank Roy Prouty from CUSS, Meghna our Director of Government Affairs from USMSC, David Gray from CUSF, as well as Chair Brewer, Chair Patricio, and Vice Chancellor Patric Hogan and Assistant Vice Chancellor Andy Clark for helping to organize this. It was the first time in several years that Advocacy Day was arranged in person, and certainly my first time, and I think it was a success.
