- 1) 8.32 – Meeting called to order by Ryan
- 2) 8.33 – Approval of September 2025 CUSF Executive Committee minutes (motion Weiwei, seconded by Lorenda)
- 3) 8.33 – Report from USM by Alison Wrynn. Chancellor will be in person at Joint Council Meeting. At BOR meeting College Park Athletics and Early College Admissions were discussed. On Sunday a 2.5 day Council meeting kicked off wherein alignments of state resources were discussed, it was mentioned 400k for campuses for returning people. The issues of international students were discussed. USM received \$4.1M grant to support Prison education programs.
